Upon review of the above comparison of the number of building permits issued, construction value and building permit fees collected generated in 2012 versus 2011 the following can be determined:

- 1.) The 367 building permits issued in the year 2012 represents a increase of 25 building permits from the 367 building permits issued in 2011, or an increase of 7%.
- 2.) Construction value increased by \$2,097,315.14 from \$3,386,221.96 in 2011 to \$5,483,537.10 in 2012. This increase in construction value is evidence that economic conditions appear to be improving in the City of Lincoln and property owners are making improvements to their properties that had been put off in years past.
- 3.) Given the increase in the number of building permits issued and an increase in construction value, there resulted an 11% increase in building permit fees from \$24,537.48 in 2011 to \$27,652.37 in 2012.
- 4.) Comparison of the attached Summary of Building Reports for the years 2011 and 2012 provides further evidence that the level of reinvestment in residential properties increased in 2012, with a notable increase in the number of remodeling, roofing and siding permits.

Upon review of the above comparison of the number of ordinance violation generated during 2011 and 2012 the following can be determined:

- 1.) During 2012 the number of ordinance violations generated by the Building and Safety office continued to increase by 163 violation letters, representing an increase of 12 % from 2011.
- 2.) Given the relatively high number of violation letters generated throughout the year provides evidence that the Building and Safety Department continues to be highly committed in identifying and bringing nonconforming properties into compliance with the requirements of the City Code. While the number of grass and weed related ordinance violations were no longer a focus of the Building and Safety Department after October, the Building and Safety Department remained focused on addressing other property maintenance violations that were found to exist.
- 3.) The generation of 238 ordinance violation letters in April 2012 compared to 105 ordinance violation letters being generated in April 2011 represented a focused effort by the Building and Safety Department to get a jump on properties in violation of the City Code and give the department more time to work with affected property owners over the course of the summer.
